learning disabilities and was soon promoted to the role of senior support worker.


Sarah then moved onto the role of home manager where she project managed the building of a new care home for adults with learning difficulties.


Days out.....

Specialist training....

Oakleigh Lodge have recently arranged for staff to take part in bespoke specialist training tailored to our service users and is provided by Dudley MBC.

We received Safeguarding – responding to and preventing abuse, which was provided by Dudley MBC Safeguarding team. The aims of this course are to ensure that all staff recognize they have a role to play in reducing the likelihood of abuse happening to the people they support, their responsibilities when responding to concerns of neglect or abuse and being able to identify specific areas of vulnerability for the people they support and ways they can help to minimize risk.

Staff are taking part in Autism Awareness training this month on the 14th and 28th of October. Again this training is tailored to our service users. The course is split into three modules:

- Characteristics and individuality.
- Effective communication with individuals on the Autistic spectrum
- Behaviour and person centred support.

The aim of this course is for it's participants to reflect on their current work practices and to consider how this would influence their practice when supporting adults who are on the autistic spectrum.
